## Matt. 5:1-12

In verse 1 through 12 we see the word <u>blessed</u> nine times which means <u>happiness</u>. Our Heavenly Father wants us to be happy. Happiness should result in rejoicing and gladness.

6Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled.

<sup>7</sup>Blessed are the merciful: for they shall obtain mercy.

8Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God.

<sup>9</sup>Blessed are the peacemakers: for they shall be called the children of God.

10Blessed are they which <u>are persecuted for righteousness' sake</u>: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

11<u>Blessed</u> are ye, when men shall <u>revile you, and persecute you, and shall</u> say all manner of evil against you falsely, for my sake.

12<u>Rejoice, and be exceeding glad: for great is your reward in heaven: for so persecuted they the prophets which were before you.</u>

Don't you feel blessed? God says we are! If He says I am, then I am!
