New Year's resolution....

The idea of a "New Year's Resolution" sounds easy, but it is not. Coming up with a "New Year's Resolution" and sticking with it, is the main part. If you make a "New Year's Resolution" you really need to keep it. This is a promise to yourself, that you will not do, whatever it was, that you were doing wrong for the past year(s). I made some good ones that have changed my life. It is very productive and I would suggest everyone to make at least one "New Year's Resolution".
