A Love Story

On December 21st., I was watching a movie titled Fireproof starring Kirk Cameron who played a fireman that had marital problems. I'd seen this movie before but this time I got a blessing for I noticed things that I'd never paid attention to the first time.

The boys earthly father gave him a journal to use as a guide to straighten out his family problems that previously worked for his parents. The boy and his wife were not saved at the time of the problems.

In the movie He and his dad met and talked in a park. The father was standing at the foot of a large cross when the boy asked his father, "How many times do I have to try?" This brought to my mind of the scripture of how many times are we to forgive; **Matt. 18:22; Jesus saith unto him, I say not unto thee, Until seven times: but, Until seventy times seven.** I could just imagine seeing Jesus at the foot of this cross on television quoting this scripture.

The boy had originally promised his dad to stay in the marriage for 40 weeks while trying to work through their problems because it would have taken 40 weeks to go through the journal to complete. Was it strength or faith he needed to complete his promise? **Is. 40:31 says: But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.**

The boy gave his heart to God and waited, while they played a song titled I'm Waiting On You Lord.

This was a good ending of a love story because they got back together. The greatest love story ever told or ever will be is the untold love story between our Savior and us! He wants the best for all of us. But more than anything else He wants our love first, last and always!
