<u>Job 42:15</u> And in all the land were no women found so fair as the daughters of Job: and their father gave them inheritance among their brethren.


<u>Dan 1:15</u> And at the end of ten days their countenances appeared fairer and fatter in flesh than all the children which did eat the portion of the king's meat.
