What A Battle!

Warfare; Overcome; Flesh and Blood; Conquerors; satan; Full Armor and God:

The Lord never told us that that when we became Christians our lives would be easy or perfect. In John 16:33; He tells us: *These things I have spoken to you, so that in Me you may have peace. In the world you have tribulation, but take courage; I have overcome the world.*" If you are a true child of God you know His Word to be true.

We are continually at war with satan, (I never cap his name for he's unworthy). That's why Pastor Dendy tells us before his feet ever hit the floor in the morning he has his talk with the Lord because before the day is over we will be in a spiritual warfare.

These battles we have to learn to fight ourselves. No one else can fight them for us. Do you have failures every day in your spiritual life? That means satan is doing his job. Are we doing ours? What is the full armor? (Eph. 6:13-17;) ¹³ Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. ¹⁴ Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breast-plate of righteousness; ¹⁵ And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; ¹⁶ Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. ¹⁷ And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God:

How do we put this armor on? By FAITH in GOD! I pray this new year we all start a new life with Christ and be fitted for our new clothing, the Full Armor of Christ!
