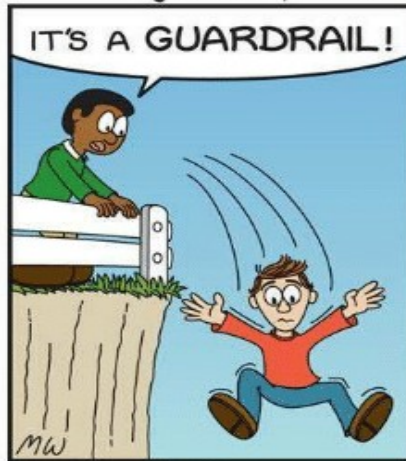

Story Summary:

- God gives of Himself for the benefit and ultimate good of others.
- God's love is at the center of His other attributes. Out of God's love comes His kindness, grace, etc.
 - Where Do We See This in Scripture?
- "God is love" (I John 4:16) and He is described as "the God of love" (II Cor. 13:11).
- "Anyone who does not love does not know God, because God is love" (I John 4:8).
- "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son..." (John 3:16).
- "God shows His love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us" (Rom. 5:8; note I John 4:9-10).
- God's love for us will never end because His love is based on His unchanging nature. This endless love was shown to Israel in the Old Testament (Jer. 31:3), just as it is shown to us today (Eph. 5:25).
