Psalms 20:7 says "Some trust in chariots and some in horses, but we will remember the name of the Lord our God". God uses different means to supply our needs. For example we were in a revival in our church and our battery went out in our jeep. We had no money. My brother carried it to the house. We had the battery charged and it was still working good when we got rid of the jeep. When I testified what God had done, the pastor told me after the service that God had told her to buy us a battery. She didn't but God provided. Read Psalms 37. We are headed to the end of the church age. Persecution of the saints is coming and we must be rooted and grounded in the Lord. We must trust God completely for everything. We need to rest and know in whom we believe. When Jesus ascended into heaven he commanded us to receive the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is our rest, our helper, our guide, our comforter. When we can't do things in ourselves, with his help and guidance we can do all He asks. I urge you to seek to know God in his fullness. That is so important for us today.
