**Our scripture for this week: Matt. 7:15-20:**

(15) Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravenous wolves. (16) You will know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes from thorn bushes or figs from thistles? (17) Even so, every good tree bears good fruit, but a bad tree bears bad fruit. (18) A good tree cannot bear bad fruit, nor can a bad tree bear good fruit. (19) Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. (20) Therefore by their fruits you will know them.

SCRIPTURES TO HELP IN OUR DAILY LIVES

**Overcome evil with good:**

Romans 12:21 says, "Be not overcome of evil, but overcome evil with good."

**Pray for those who oppose your faith:**

Matt. 5:11-12 says, "Blessed are ye, when men shall revile you, and persecute you, and shall say all manner of evil against you falsely, for my sake. <sup>12</sup>Rejoice, and be exceeding glad: for great is your reward in heaven: for so persecuted they the prophets which were before you."

**Be content with what you have & where you are:**

Phil. 4:11 says, "Not that I speak in respect of want: for I have learned, in whatsoever state I am, therewith to be content."

**Let your light shine no matter what:**

Matt. 5:16 says, "Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven."

**Let your speech always be pleasant:**

Col. 4:6 says, "Let your speech be always with grace, seasoned with salt, that ye may know how ye ought to answer every man."

**Rejoice always:**

Phil. 4:4 says, "Rejoice in the Lord always: and again I say, 'Rejoice.'"

**Expect adversity:**

Read James 1:1-27- James tells us to expect adversity.

<sup>8</sup>Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things.

**Forgive over & over again:**

Matt 18:22 says, "Jesus saith unto him, I say not unto thee, Until seven times: but, Until seventy times seven."

**Let love rule your life:**

1 Co 13:4-7 says, "<sup>4</sup>Charity suffereth long, and is kind; charity envieth not; charity vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up, <sup>5</sup>Doth not behave itself unseemly, seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil; <sup>6</sup>Rejoiceth not in iniquity, but rejoiceth in the truth; <sup>7</sup>Beareth all things, believeth all things, hopeth all things, endureth all things.

**Do unto others as you would have them do unto you:**

Matt 7:12 says, "Therefore all things whatsoever ye would that men should do to you, do ye even so to them: for this is the law and the prophets."

**Love the Lord your God with all your being:**

Deut 6:5 says, "And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might."
