Philippians 4:19 And my God shall supply all my needs according to his riches in glory, by Christ Jesus. This is a statement which is true for God's people. We must trust, obey, and then patiently wait in faith, believing. God's timing is perfect. Let's not forget that we must ask. We never assume or take things for granted. Read 2 Kings 7:1-9 for an account of how God spoke through His Prophet that he was going to feed his people when they were besieged and starving. Now let's look at a prophecy that the recipient had to wait for years for it to be fulfilled. Abraham waited for many years for the arrival of a son that, through his seed, all the nations of the world would be blessed. Through our Savior, Jesus, was that promise fulfilled.
