### [#37 The Standard of Truth](#)

**Isa 8:20** To the law and to the testimony: if they speak not according to this word, it is because there is no light in them.

**Mat 15:1** Then came to Jesus scribes and Pharisees, which were of Jerusalem, saying,

**Mat 15:2** Why do thy disciples transgress the tradition of the elders? for they wash not their hands when they eat bread.

**Mat 15:3** But he answered and said unto them, Why do ye also transgress the commandment of God by your tradition?

**Mar 7:7** Howbeit in vain do they worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men.

**Mar 7:8** For laying aside the commandment of God, ye hold the tradition of men, as the washing of pots and cups: and many other such like things ye do.

**Mar 7:9** And he said unto them, Full well ye reject the commandment of God, that ye may keep your own tradition.
