## From the pastor's desk

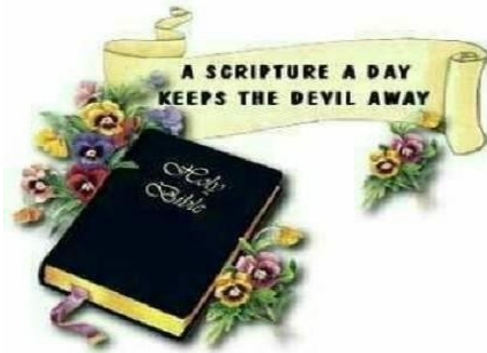
Sunday, 2-26-2012
