FOOD FOR THOUGHT

Some churches have suggested that preaching is an outdated way of spreading the gospel and that the sermon should be done differently, replaced with dialogue, movies or films, dramatic presentations and entertainment. Sermons should never be replaced unless it's the Holy Ghost and the alters are filling. (My Opinion). Churches that are moving away from making sermons the main point of a worship service, are they presenting the full Gospel? That decision is between you and God...

In **Is. 61:1-3**, we are told about God calling someone to preach and teach the Word of God to other people in this world. You should not preach unless you are called to preach. It says in **Is. 61:1-3**, **1 The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound; 2. To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all that mourn; 3. To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified.**

Read scriptures: Lu. 4:18; The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised,

Matt. 4:23; And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people.

Mark 1:37; And when they had found him, they said unto him, All men seek for thee. Jesus did not put off His preaching. He said, Mark 1:38; And he said unto them, Let us go into the next towns, that I may preach there also: for therefore came I forth. Lu. 24:47; And that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in his name among all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.

Some people today try to stay in touch with the thought that preaching is not the popular or in thing in the church as I said in the first paragraph. But Jesus never put off his sermon. If the congregation hears giving they learn to give. If they hear God's Word they learn to hear and love it, if they come to church with their Bibles they learn to like reading it, how to find scriptures and maybe even discernment of the Spirit. If they come to see anything else then that's what they get use to and expect to see.

I hope we all come to hear the Good News! What is the Good News? God's Word is the "GOOD NEWS!"
