THE BEATITUDES

The Beatitudes, in Matthew 5:3-11, (read V. 12 also), are the *meek*, the *merciful*, the *pure of heart*, and the *peacemakers*. "Beatitude" is from the Latin word *beatitudo*, meaning "blessedness." Jesus is speaking blessings to us while preaching, The Sermon On The Mount.

The Bible is full of blessings that I'm sure some of us have never read or heard. It would be good if we checked them out for ourselves.

The phrase "blessed are" in each of the beatitudes implies a current state of happiness or well-being. The expression held a meaning of "divine joy and perfect happiness" to the people. In other words, Jesus was saying "divinely happy and fortunate are" those who possess these inward qualities.

It may sound as if He's telling us to be a wimp. Not so! While speaking of a current "blessedness," each pronouncement also promises a future reward. He wants happiness for us all but we have to possess the qualities below.

Please read for yourself, then Read Luke 6:20-23. The Sermon on the Plain is somewhat similar. It also speaks of blessings.

- ³ Blessed are the poor in spirit: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- ⁴Blessed are they that mourn: for they shall be comforted.
- ⁵ Blessed are the meek: for they shall inherit the earth.
- ⁶ Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled.
- ⁷ Blessed are the merciful: for they shall obtain mercy.
- 8 Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God.
- ⁹ Blessed are the peacemakers: for they shall be called the children of God.
- 10 Blessed are they which are persecuted for righteousness' sake: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- ¹¹ Blessed are ye, when men shall revile you, and persecute you, and shall say all manner of evil against you falsely, for my sake.
- ¹² Rejoice, and be exceeding glad: for great is your reward in heaven: for so persecuted they the prophets which were before you.
