<u>2 Co 9:10</u> Now he that ministereth seed to the sower both minister bread for your food, and multiply your seed sown, and increase the fruits of your righteousness;)

**Eph 3:18** (Abundant Power) May be able to comprehend with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height;

**Eph 3:19** And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God.

**Psa 36:6** (Abundant Joy) Thy righteousness is like the great mountains: thy judgments are a great deep: O LORD, thou preservest man and beast.

**Psa 36:7** How excellent is thy lovingkindness. O God! therefore the children of men put their trust under the shadow of thy wings.

**Psa 36:8** They shall be abundantly satisfied with the fatness of thy house; and thou shalt make them drink of the river of thy pleasures.

Psa 36:9 For with thee is the fountain of life: in thy light shall we see light.
