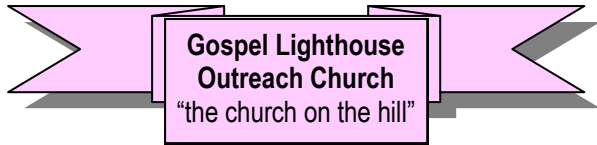

Look a little further down to verse 17 and you'll read that our faith would be meaningless if there had been no resurrection, (¹⁷ **And if Christ be not raised, your faith is vain; ye are yet in your sins.**)

And it tells that Jesus was resurrected in verse 20, (²⁰ **But now is Christ risen from the dead, and become the first fruits of them that slept.**)

It's easy to say, "*I believe,*" when you were there to witness such an event as Paul was, but if you believe and never saw Him then is where our *Faith* comes in.
