Our scripture for this week:

Isaiah. 40:31; But they that **wait upon the LORD** shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.

Easter; Resurrection Sunday;

This is the most Holy Day of all in a Christians walk in faith. It is the day that Jesus Christ rose from the tomb where He was buried after He was crucified for all our sins.

If you've never read about it read these passages:

Matt. 29:1-8, Mark16:1-8, Luke 24:1-12 all tell of the empty tomb. Matt. 28:9-20, Mark 16:9-20, Luke 24:13-53 & John 20:1-25 tells about the resurrection appearance of Jesus.

Please read it for yourself my words only cover a tid bit of the story.

It tells of those who went to the tomb with spices to anoint His body. On their way they were concerned how they would roll the huge rock from the entrance but as they arrived it was already rolled away. They saw a young man sitting on the side, dressed in a white robe. He told them Jesus had risen and they should go tell His disciples and Peter that He had gone into Galilee and they will see him there.

On the way to their destination two of them were going to Emmaus about seven miles from Jerusalem talking about things that had happened. Jesus himself drew near and went with them. But their eyes were kept from recognizing Him. Jesus told later on of scriptures of things concerning himself. He said," Was it not necessary that the Christ should suffer these things and enter into his glory?" And a little later He said to them, "See my hands and my feet, that it is I myself. Touch me, and see. For a spirit does not have flesh and bones as you see that I have." And when he had said this, he showed them his hands and his feet.

Then he opened their minds to understand the Scriptures, and said to them, "Thus it is written, that the Christ should suffer and on the third day rise from the dead, and that repentance and forgiveness of sins should be proclaimed in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem.

Jesus is alive today sitting on the right hand of His Father making intercession for us all. He wants us to repent of our sins and spend eternity in Heaven with Him. He loves all saints and sinners! Think about it! Heaven or Hell is the only choice we have!
