**Psa 132:13** For the LORD hath chosen Zion; he hath desired it for his habitation.

**Psa 132:14** This is my rest for ever: here will I dwell; for I have desired it.

**Psa 132:15** I will abundantly bless her provision: I will satisfy her poor with bread.

**Psa 132:16** I will also clothe her priests with salvation: and her saints shall shout aloud for joy.

**Isa 30:21** And thine ears shall hear a word behind thee, saying, This is the way, walk ye in it, when ye turn to the right hand, and when ye turn to the left.

**Isa 30:22** Ye shall defile also the covering of thy graven images of silver, and the ornament of thy molten images of gold: thou shalt cast them away as a menstrual cloth; thou shalt say unto it, Get thee hence.

**Isa 30:23** Then shall he give the rain of thy seed, that thou shalt sow the ground withal; and bread of the increase of the earth, and it shall be fat and plenteous: in that day shall thy cattle feed in large pastures.

**Isa 30:24** The oxen likewise and the young asses that ear the ground shall eat clean provender, which hath been winnowed with the shovel and with the fan.

From the Pastors: We are blessed, We are blessed everyday that we live we are blessed! All day everyday we are blessed and we can say "Praise the Lord for He is good!"


