Attitude (the state of mind toward something)

The attitude of Christians:

Then with love and respect submit all your heart to God and <u>Obey</u> as in John 14:15, 23, ¹⁵ If ye love me, keep my commandments. ²³ Jesus answered and said unto him, If a man love me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him.

If we want that abode, (residence), with God we need to follow Him. Jesus said in Matthew 16:24; Then said Jesus unto his disciples, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me. When we follow Christ our paths should become different than the old because it is the path of discipleship, of following Jesus.
