A Mother's Love Story

It would be great if all mothers loved their children as Jochebed the biological mother of Moses. We all should know the story of Moses. How much his mother loved him and tried to save him by giving him up to a basket floating down the Nile River because Pharaoh had decreed all baby boys under two years be killed and Moses was barely three months old at the time.

Jochebed floated Moses down the Nile to protect him because of her love for him, not to harm him. His sister, Miriam, hid and watched to find out what happened to him.

On Sunday, April 28, 2013, I was wondering as Pastor Dendy was preaching about Moses, **“What was his biological name?”** After searching, it was actually Moses' biological mother, Jochebed, who gave Moses his name.

Bithiah, Pharaoh's daughter, was the one who took Moses from the river, then hired Jochebed, his mother, to nurse him for her. Jochebed later told Pharaoh's daughter the child's Hebrew name in Hebrew, then Bithiah also called him by this name, remarking that this name was indeed appropriate, since she had drawn him out of the water.

Jochebed loved Moses enough that she had rather someone else might find him and raise him as their own, than him to be killed if they found him with her. God worked it out for her to raise her own son herself. Miracle? Yes, I'd think so!

God is still in the miracle business today!

If all mothers today were like Jochebed, we would not have child abuse, murders, abortions and such. Mother's love your children ! They are a gift from God. Amen!
