<u>Act 23:1</u> And Paul, earnestly beholding the council, said, Men and brethren, I have lived in all good conscience before God until this day.

Rom 2:15 Which shew the work of the law written in their hearts, their conscience also bearing witness, and their thoughts the mean while accusing or else excusing one another;

Rom 13:5 Wherefore ye must needs be subject, not only for wrath, but also for conscience sake.
