Can A Christian Lose Salvation?

When a person is converted and becomes a Christian, God gives them a new mind. The old mind was to serve the worldly lusts. The new mind is to serve God and do what pleases Him. This is where salvation begins. The old man and his mind is dead. The new man and his mind start a new life with salvation through Jesus Christ.

This is what Paul speaks about in **Ephesians 4:22-24: ²² That ye put off concerning the former conversation, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts; ²³ And be renewed in the spirit of your mind; ²⁴ And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.**

Paul writes in **Romans 6:6; ⁶ Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin.**

Salvation means that we don't only receive forgiveness for our sins through Jesus' death but our old man was also crucified with Him. This is what makes it possible for us to live a new life.

Paul writes in **Philippians 3:17-19: ¹⁷ Brethren, be followers together of me, and mark them which walk so as ye have us for an ensample. ¹⁸ (For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, that they are the enemies of the cross of Christ: ¹⁹ Whose end is destruction, whose God is their belly, and whose glory is in their shame, who mind earthly things.)**

As long as they were receiving forgiveness of sins through Jesus' sacrifice, they were not considered enemies of the cross. But they were enemies of the cross concerning their old man being crucified with Christ. They may have once been converted and received a new mind but, they had turned back to the old mind and begun to love this world again. This was sin.

In **2 Timothy 3:5**, it talks about some who had a form of godliness but denied the power of it. The power lies in the cross, because it is the cross that is the power of God unto salvation.

It is the cross that keeps our old man crucified so that we can grow in the new life. But the old mind that loves the world and its lust, is an abomination to God. We can't serve two God's. We have to serve God or the world. If a man turns back to the old mind, loving this world and enjoying the lusts, then they lose their salvation, and can't enter into heaven. But if they truly repent and turn back to God, they can regain their salvation, but then they have also lost precious time where they could have been growing in Christ. So let us continue in this new mind and be firmly established in it.
