A hot tear ran down my right side of my face, I said," oh Jesus." The pain left instantly. I have never had another attack since. That has been over 35 years ago. The doctor said that they could very little for me. Just the shots or maybe surgery. Through the name of Jesus I'm cured. I give God glory and praise for all He's done. As time goes on I will testify of all the miracles God has done for me. Am I super special to God? No More than any other faith believing, blood bought Christian.
