1. **I love the LORD, because he hath heard my voice and my supplications.**
2. **Because he hath inclined his ear unto me, therefore will I call upon him as long as I live.**

Quiet time and fellowship with God is the most important part of each day. It's always best to talk to Him the very first thing in the morning. Why?
