The word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is the word of faith which we preach.(17) Faith cometh by hearing, hearing by the word of God. Deuteronomy 11:18 Therefore shall ye lay up my words, in your heart and in your soul; and bind them for a sign upon your hands, that they may be as frontlets between your eyes. (reminder) Colossians 3:16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another, in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs singing with grace in your heart to the Lord The word teaches us how to live in peace and joy.
