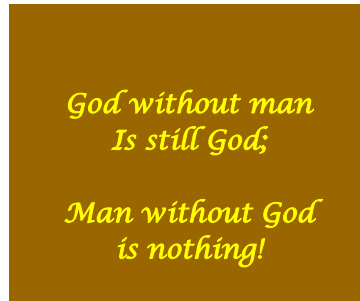

What Really Makes People Unclean

Read, Matthew 15:10-20

Last week, I went to the grocery store to pick up a few things. While I was shopping, I was thinking what I should or shouldn't buy mostly because of the prices. I try to shop for what is in season then it possibly will be a few cents cheaper.

Then it came to me, "What if Jesus had to pay for the food he feed the people in His day?" Most of them had certain foods they would or wouldn't eat because they claimed it clean or unclean.

But in **Matthew 15:10-20**, Jesus explains to the multitude of people saying, "**Hear, and understand:** It's not what goes into the mouth that defileth man but it's what comes out of the mouth that defileth man.

After the Pharisees heard this they were offended. Then Jesus said, "Every plant, which my heavenly Father hath not planted, shall be rooted up." Let all of them alone and be blind leaders of the blind, they will all fall in the ditch."

Jesus went on to explain to Peter that whatsoever entered into the mouth went into the belly and is cast out into the draught. But the things that came out of the mouth comes from the heart and is what defileth man.

The thoughts that proceed out of the heart through the mouth hurt people, even today. Evil thoughts against someone, killing, being unfaithful to your spouse, fornication, stealing, lying, and blasphemies are things we should avoid, if we want to walk with Jesus.

These are the things that defile a man not just not washing your hands before you eat as the scribes and Pharisees, which were of Jerusalem, were complaining about.

When I was a child, as most of you, when mom called, "**Come and eat!**" It did us no good to go to the table till our dirty little faces and hands were washed and hair combed because you were sent from the table to the bathroom to do so. Then when we got back, most of the good chicken was gone. So we learned fast!

It made no difference what was on the table to eat, biscuits and gravy only or chicken and potatoes, the food was blessed the same had it been a prime rib. We were thankful in good times and bad for God always provided for us.

Acts 10:13-15 says:

¹³ And there came a voice to him, Rise, Peter; kill, and eat.

¹⁴ But Peter said, Not so, Lord; for I have never eaten anything that is common or unclean.

¹⁵ And the voice spake unto him again the second time, What God hath cleansed, that call not thou common.
