Shekinah Glory of God;

(Cloud; Glory of God:)

Some say they have heard about the Shekinia, (Shechinah), Glory of God but have never read it in the Bible. It isn't in the Bible as far as I can tell. But its concept is. The expression, a form of a Hebrew word, that means "he caused to dwell," signifying that it was a divine visitation of the presence or dwelling of Jehovah God on this earth.

Shekinah was first clear when the Israelites set out from Succoth in their escape from Egypt. There it appeared as a cloudy pillar in the day and a fiery pillar by night: KJV bible: In ([Exodus 13:20-22](#)), it says, ²⁰ And they took their journey from Succoth, and encamped in Etham, in the edge of the wilderness. ²¹ And the LORD went before them by day in a pillar of a cloud, to lead them the way; and by night in a pillar of fire, to give them light; to go by day and night: ²² He took not away the pillar of the cloud by day, nor the pillar of fire by night, from before the people. "After leaving Succoth they camped at Etham on the edge of the desert. By day the LORD went ahead of them, in a pillar of cloud, to guide them on their way and by night in a pillar of fire, to give them light, so that they could travel by day or night, to see.

Other scriptures referring to the Shekinah Glory of God are:

Please check them out for yourself!

[Ex. 25:21-22](#); ²¹ And thou shalt put the mercy seat above upon the ark; and in the ark thou shalt put the testimony that I shall give thee. ²² And there I will meet with thee, and I will commune with thee from above the mercy seat, from between the two cherubims, (A Cherub or Cherubim is a type of angel usually involved in sacred work before God. They are generally described as winged creatures with feet and hands.), which are upon the ark of the testimony, of all things which I will give thee in commandment unto the children of Israel.

[Cloud; Lev. 16:2](#); here the scripture tells about the Lord telling Moses that he die not, for I will appear in the cloud upon the mercy seat. [Cloud; Ex. 40:34-35](#), 34. It tells, "then a cloud covered the tent of the congregation, the glory of the Lord filled the tabernacle." ³⁵. Moses could not enter the tent because the cloud abode thereon, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle. [Cloud; 2 Chron. 5:13-14](#); for the glory of the LORD had filled the house of God. [Glory of God; 2 Chron. 7: 1](#); and the glory of the LORD filled the house. [Ezek. 10:18-19](#); and the glory of the God of Israel was over them above. [Rev. 21:22-23](#); ²³ And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the glory of God did lighten it, and the Lamb is the light there of.
