Our scripture for this week:

DO YOU FELLOWSHIP WITH WRONG THINGS?

SCRIPTURE: (1 Corinthians 6:14-17 ¹⁴ And God hath both raised up the Lord, and will also raise up us by his own power. ¹⁵ Know ye not that your bodies are the members of Christ? shall I then take the members of Christ, and make them the members of an harlot? God forbid. ¹⁶ What? know ye not that he which is joined to an harlot is one body? for two, saith he, shall be one flesh. ¹⁷ But he that is joined unto the Lord is one spirit.

I wonder how many of us have willingly joined ourselves with the world, as if the world can provide the abundance we crave. Let's remind ourselves of what the Scripture says about abstaining, (stay away from), from evil. Don't Have Fellowship with Unholy Practices!

(James 4:4). Ye adulterers and adulteresses, know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity ("Hatred, ill will," the feelings of an enemy.) with God? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God.

1. Don't Have Fellowship with Unholy Pleasures. (Col. 3:5). Mortify, (practice self-denial of one's body and appetites), therefore your members which are upon the earth; fornication, uncleanness, inordinate affection, evil concupiscence, and covetousness, which is idolatry:)
2. Don't Have Fellowship with Unholy Prophets (Phil. 3:2. Beware of dogs, beware of evil workers, beware of the concision.)
3. Don't Have Fellowship with Unholy People (1 Cor. 5:11; But now I have written unto you not to keep company, if any man that is called a brother be a fornicator, or covetous, or an idolator, or a railer, or a drunkard, or an extortioner; with such an one no not to eat.) & (2 Thess. 3:6; Now we command you, brethren, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye withdraw yourselves from every brother that walketh disorderly, and not after the tradition which he received of us.)
4. Don't Have Fellowship with Unholy Places (2 Co. 6:16 And what agreement hath the temple of God with idols? for ye are the temple of the living God; as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people.).

No doubt that we will encounter ungodliness constantly in this world, and we must if we are to minister to the world. However, God's command is clear: And I believe this to be one of our pastor's favorite scriptures, (2 Co. 6:17 " Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you.) "

Decline the invitations of the world! Accept the good that God has for you! And you will reap the benefits! Amen!
