WHY DO YOU THINK THE ANGELS APPEARED TO THE SHEPHERDS

Lu. 2:8-20: Read the verses

(8). And there were in the same country shepherds abiding in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night

Have you ever wondered why the angels, at the birth of Jesus, didn't appear to someone else beside the shepherds? Why not someone of importance? Would you want or think that Jesus, the Prince of Peace would be born in such conditions? He was even buried in a borrowed tomb. Jesus did not come to earth to do away with all difficulties. He was to bring peace to the world. Today, He offers us an inner peace no matter what's happening around us.

The bible states Jesus had descended, as to His earthly nature, from the line of David, the Shepherd-King who had once kept flocks in those very same fields. Now another Shepherd King the son of David is born. There was no building big enough to hold the angelic numbers that night, 10,000 times 10,000 angels. Under the open sky in the field was the only place large enough to contain them.
